Scenario A+

Improvements in Scenario A, plus: LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT TO MIRAMAR and CONGESTION PRICING

Light rail would deliver frequent, reliable, fast, congestion-free public transport from the central city to Newtown, Kilbirnie and Miramar. This would foster high-quality transit-oriented development along the route and around stops. Congestion pricing would reduce peak traffic volumes and encourage people to get around without driving.

Cost: \$900m - \$1.2b
Time to construct: 7-10 years

Higher priority for people walking along key routes and at selected intersections in the central city.

Cycle lanes along key routes connected to the north and south cycleways.

High priority public transport lanes from station to basin.

Remove peak-hour parking on Vivian St.

Improve Basin layout (without bridges or tunnels)
